



FACILITY & GAME RULES

(MUST BE SIGNED BY ALL TEAM MEMBERS)

ACTION NETBALL

TEAM FEES:

A R70 non-refundable registration fee per player must be paid at the time of registration. The remaining fees of R70 per player must be paid before the start of each game. Players are allowed to pay own fees at the Arena, the receipt must be handed to the captain of the team who will then keep track of team player payments. Teams will not be allowed to start a game if all game fees are not fully paid. This will make sure that the captains don't become liable for outstanding fees.

Indoor Team Rosters is due prior to the beginning of your first game. Players may be added to your roster up to the third game. The roster limit size is 10 players per team. Players must play at least 30% of the total league games for the player to qualify for the quarter, semi and finals. Teams playing an illegal player will forfeit any games in which the illegal player had played and will not be refunded on game fees. Opposing team will benefit with points as forfeited game. Bosjol Multi Sports Arena Management has final authority on all roster questions.

UMPIRES:

Each game played at Bosjol Multi Sports Arena will consist of at least 2 umpires for games if available. Teams that forfeit must pay the referee fees of (R70 per umpire) for both umpires, as the game was scheduled and they had to drive all the way to umpire the game, and will not be allowed to play their next game until the umpires fees from the forfeited game have been paid. The Umpires decision are final. Umpire/player misconduct needs to be reported to Bosjol Multi Sports Arena Management.

DIVISIONS

The divisions will be set out after the grading game, we will try our best to divide teams according to age and competitive level. When entering your team, please let us know if you are entering for the competitive level, or the social level, we will try to put all competitive level participant teams in a league. If you only want to play for fun and exercise, we will put you in the social league.

LEAGUE STANDINGS:

Standings are based on the following point system:

3 points for a win.

1 point for a tie

0 points for a loss.

1 point for every goal scored

2 points for paying game fees before each game.

Teams receiving an extra game in a session (which is occasionally necessary when there are an odd number of teams in a league, will not be awarded any points for the extra game).

FORFEITURE OF A GAME

If Captains is changed during league, the old captain must ensure that the new captain signed the registration form when handing over, if not old captain will be held responsible for any withdrawal from league/forfeit game moneys. Teams that are not ready to take the field at game time could be made to forfeit. The minimum number of players needed to avoid a forfeit is 5 players. If a team does not have the minimum requirement on field in 5 minutes into their game time, the opposing team will receive a forfeit win.

PRACTICE / TRAINING TIME

When available, the indoor field may be rented for R200 per hour, and R20-00 per trainee towards arena, and coach to set their price.

UNIFORMS & EQUIPMENT

Players on each team must have shirts with pants on at all times. No barefoot playing, only running shoes. Equipment like (Bibs, balls) will be provided. If a team are using their own bibs, all letter printings must be clear to the umpire, if not you will be asked to use the Arena's bibs. No two teams to use the same colour bibs when playing against each other.

PLAYER AND COACH CONDUCT

NO FIGHTING WILL BE ALLOWED, FIRST OFFENSE IS SUSPENSION FROM THE CURRENT GAME, SECOND OFFENSE IS SUSPENSION FROM THE LEAGUE AND THIRD OFFENSE IS SUSPENSION FROM THE FACILITY. ANY PLAYERS OR SPECTATORS LEAVING THE BENCH TO JOIN IN A FIGHT WILL RECEIVE THE SAME SUSPENSION.

We have CCTV recordings, recording the games, if unsure of any decisions, please see management so that the footage can be looked at, before any fighting.

Bosjol Multi Sports Arena Management will have final authority on all disciplinary actions. No refunds of any kind will be given. Any player ejected from a game must leave the facility immediately.

ARGUING CALLS

To eliminate any issues and to make sure we enjoy the game of netball, there will be zero tolerance for arguing with umpires. You may ask a question in a polite way, but if it is during the game the Umpire won't be able to respond with an answer since there is play going on and their focus should be on the game. Please feel free to ask during half time or after the game. Any arguing with an umpire

whether you are on the court or off the court will result in an -10 penalty for the team on their final score, as well as a yellow card.

CAUTIONS & EJECTIONS:

YELLOW CARD	-	First offense	-	A foul and warning
BLUE CARD	-	Second offence	-	Ejected from game for 5-minute bench time
RED CARD	-	Third offence	-	Ejected from game

Any player receiving 3 penalties in the same game will be given a red card and be ejected from the game. After any player is ejected for any reason, the umpire will fill out a misconduct report at management at the conclusion of the game. The ejected player/team manager will be notified by Bosjol Multi Sports Arena regarding their playing status.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

Players from first division are not allowed to play as a substitute in the second division. Players from second division may however play as a substitute in the first division.

AWARDS:

All participating teams will receive a reward at the end of the league. Any combination of trophies, medals, t-shirt, drinks, other merchandise etc, will be awarded to the winners.

SUBSTITUTIONS

3 players from the roster of the team, may be substituted during the game, provided the ball is not in play. At halftime, during injuries with permission of the umpire. A team may be penalized for faulty substitutions.

INJURIES

The clock will not be stopped on minor injuries. Coaches may assist players off the field at the umpire's request. Bleeding is considered an injury. Any player bleeding must leave the field of play and cannot return until the wound is covered. Bloody clothing is not permitted on the field of play.

JEWELRY / NAILS

No jewellery will be allowed on the field. Nails must be short if not you need to bring your own gloves to play with.

FOULS

Captains are required to maintain a safe environment for all players. If necessary, a member of Bosjol Multi Sports Arena staff will monitor the game. If a foul occurs (for example: pushing, tripping, intentional hurting of another player) a free goal will be award to the opposing team, and after the third warning may be suspended from the game.
